Zoom Assembly Guidelines

As you may know by now each class teacher will be holding a Zoom Class Assembly for the pupils through Zoom technology every Friday for the month of June. The teachers, SNAs, Attendance Ted and Ms. Mc Nulty are really looking forward to seeing and chatting with all the girls and boys as we miss them all very much.

In order to facilitate the smooth running of these half hour assemblies please ensure you discuss the rules and guidelines for using this technology with your child before allowing them to use it.

Please be aware that if you are using a phone or tablet device the Zoom app will need to be downloaded in advance.

If you are using an ordinary laptop or computer the app does not need to be downloaded and an ordinary internet browser can be used.

Important: If the class teacher has not received your email address then you will not be able to participate. Please email your class teacher if you have not already done so. Teacher email addresses are on the website - in the weekly lesson plans. In providing your email address you are consenting to the school contacting you via email.

Guidelines which must be followed:

1. The class teacher (Host) invites pupils (Members) to participate in the assembly by sending an invite email which will include the date, time and option to join the meeting/assembly. (This invite will be sent the evening before. Please remember to check your junk email if you cannot not find it.)
2. Assemblies will last 30 minutes. It will give the pupils an opportunity to see all their friends and share some news, if they wish. We understand that some pupils may be shy and prefer not to share their news. This is absolutely fine. They may like to draw a picture and share it with their classmates instead.

3. Pupils should be logged in and ready to participate at the time given by the class teacher. (Details will be included in the weekly lesson plan) Pupils are to be dressed appropriately for assembly i.e. no pyjamas.
4. Pupils should take part in this online assembly in a suitably quiet space, away from background noise, if possible.
5. A parent/guardian or other responsible adult, must be in the room with the child during this assembly call for supervision purposes. Please put your child's microphone on mute when joining the assembly and teachers will unmute each pupil accordingly.
6. No media recordings (picture, video or otherwise) may be made of the Class Assembly screen.
7. Failure to follow the above guidelines will result in the process being withdrawn.
8. Participants can be removed for breaking guidelines.
9. Participants can only talk to the teacher when prompted and not to each other.

This is a wonderful opportunity for the pupils to engage with the teacher and see and hear their friends and their news and pictures. We hope you can join us!
